

Tips for using the Secure File Transfer Protocol Server

Download SSH client software from:

<http://rosie.biol.sc.edu/Downloads/>

Look for SSHSecureShellClient-3.2.9.exe

Install it on your PC, allow it to put an icon on your Desktop.

Open the SSH Secure File Transfer Client (from your desktop).

Click the Quick Connect button.

In the Host Name, type **emcdb.biol.sc.edu** (this is our SFTP server).

For User Name, type in lowercase: your assigned user name.

For Port Number, type in **555**

Leave the Authentication Method at Profile Settings, press enter.

It will ask you for a password, type in your password.

You should see 3 panels (which you ought to be able to resize).

The left panel is the contents of your PC, the right is your folder on the SFTP server.
The bottom panel shows the status of your file transfers.

You can drag and drop files from either side to the other.

To disconnect, you can use any of these steps:

Click on the X in the top right corner of your SSH Window

Press Alt-F4

Click on the icon above the Quick Connect box (Picture of a computer with a red stripe on it)

Once in a while you might see some error messages, it is most likely benign, and it is OK to ignore them. If your data is not accurate after transfers please notify us.
